The County Council meeting will start at 6 PM, followed by a Townhall where you will have an opportunity to pose questions to your County Officials, provide your ideas, and discuss Maltby problems and issues. Councilman Sam Low will facilitate and he has invited representatives from the County Assessors Office, PDS Enforcement and Planning, Public Works, Sherriff's office, Parks Department, and Executive Dave Somers.
